

Annual Report of Rangeen Home for the Academic Year 2020 – 2021

Schooling:

Usually the academic year begins in the first week of Nepali 1st month i.e. Baisakh which falls in mid April. But this time, due to the inconvenience created by the worldwide covid19 pandemic, the new session was started on 24th April 2020 through online.



The book distribution was done on 18th May 2020.



On 18th August 2020, we got the long awaited result of SEE (class 10) & all of us are very pleased to know that out of 9 children from Rangeen Home, 7 children got A+ Grade which means Outstanding and 2 children got A Grade which means Excellent. So we organized a simple celebration.



Examinations: Due to the pandemic, the 1st Term Exam for children from UKG to class 10 was conducted late from 13th December to 21st December 2020. The result was declared on 26th January. All our children did well in their exam & secured good result.

The exam of our class 11 children who are studying at BIA was conducted from 17th January to 24th January 2021. All the children did very well in this exam.

The 2nd Term Exam of children from U.K.G to class 10 was conducted from 5th March to 12th March 2021 and the result was declared on 20th March 2021. All the children got good result in spite of not being able to join physical classes for many days even if the school started physical classes. As we are a big family, we were worried that if one contacts the virus then it will spread easily to others.

The 2nd Term exam of class 11 children was held from 7th April to 13th April 2021. The result was declared on 23rd April. All of them got good grades.

The 3rd Term (Final) Exam of Nursery to Class 9 started from 31st May to 4th June 2021. The result was declared on 12th June 2021 and all our children got good grades. So we organized a lunch party which is sponsored by our beloved sponsor Mrs. Traudl Burgmair.

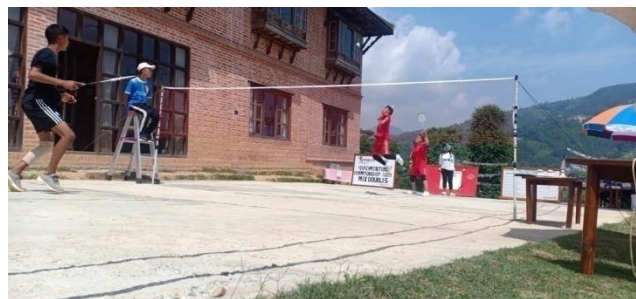

Health

We organize regular weight and BP check up of our children. We also used to organize de-worm program every 6 months.

On 29th October 2020, we took our child Taptan Gurung for eye surgery. He got conjunctival mass in his right eye. After the excision he got relief from this problem.



Festivals & functions

We celebrated Nepali New Year on 13th April 2020.





On the 15th of Nepali month Asar, the farmers in Nepal plant rice. So this day is called the National Paddy Day. The special food eaten on this day is Yogurt and beaten rice, Dahi Chewra in Nepali. We also planted rice and celebrated this festival.



Teachers' Day is traditionally observed by Hindus, Buddhists & Jains to respect and express their gratitude to their teachers. This festival is celebrated on the full moon day of Ashadh (June-July) as per the Hindu calendar. The Teachers Day actually falls on 5th July 2020 this year. But our children celebrated the same festival according to their convenience and organized this festival on 27th July 2020. Children cooked special food & entertained the staff members with many cultural items and made the day memorable.



On 14th September 2020 we organized Children's Day. This year our senior children joined the staff members and entertained the younger children with many cultural items & games. They also prepared special Newari food. The children had a great time.



We celebrated Dasain on 26th October 2020. Our children performed cultural dance and we prepared special food.



Tihar celebration: On 14th November we celebrated Laxmi Puja. We illuminated our entire building & made rangoli to welcome Goddess Laxmi, the Goddess of wealth.



On 16th November 2020, we celebrated Bhai Tika. On this day the sisters put tika on their brothers' forehead and prayed for their long lives and in return they get gifts from their brothers.



On 24th & 25th December 2020, we celebrated Christmas Eve & Christmas respectively. All the children and staff members got special gifts from our beloved sponsor Mrs. Traudl Burgmair.



We celebrated New Year 2021 on 1st January. Our children performed a short skit on covid19 and its effect on our daily lives and expected that the pandemic will come to an end so that we can lead a normal, closer life again. They also performed dance and we prepared special food.



We celebrated Losar on 12th February 2021. We prepared Khapsey which is a simple, special cookie made out of dough which is a mixture of flour, butter & little sugar/salt. We also prepared special food known as desil which is a mixture of rice, butter, resin & nuts.



The 12th Anniversary of Rangeen Home falls on 2nd March 2021. But we postponed and planned to celebrate the same with our sponsors who are expected to visit us in the end of March. As our sponsors could not visit us due to the pandemic, our 1st batch children organized a simple celebration adjusting with their school holiday.

New Admission

1) Ruksana Gurung:

On 8th October 2020, we admitted a 7 yrs old semi-orphan girl named Ruksana Gurung from Manang. Her father died and her mother cannot afford to care for Ruksana.



2 & 3) Smarika & Smriti Humagain:

On 29th November 2020 we admitted 2 semi -orphan siblings, 18 months old Smarika Humagain & 9 yrs old Smriti Humagain from Panauti, Kavre. The mother of these 2 girls died and their father cannot care for them.



4, 5, 6 & 7) Sapana Majhi, Sarashoti Majhi, Premika Majhi & Saraswati Majhi):

On 7th December 2020, we admitted 4 girls from earthquake victim families from Nuwakot. Among them 2 girls named Sapana Majhi & Sarashoti Majhi's father died in the earthquake and their mother abandoned them. The 2 other girls Premika Majhi & Saraswati Majhi's mother died and their father is very poor and cannot afford to care for his children.

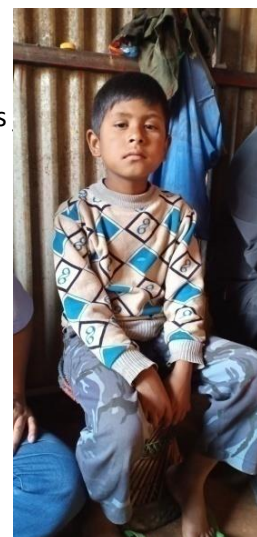

15) Sohan Pariyar:

Sohan Pariyar is from Panauti, Kavre. He was abandoned by his father when he was 8 years old. To add to his suffering, his mother died when he was 8 years old.

Since then he was living with his maternal uncle & family.

The economic condition of his uncle is very poor and cannot afford to care and educate Sohan. So we admitted Sohan to Rangeen Home on 30th April 2021.



New Projects

This year we started some new projects.

1. **Computer project:** We bought 3 laptops on 22nd February 2021. The laptops are of very great help especially during the pandemic when the children have teaching through online.



2. **Chicken project:** On 25th February 2021 we bought 61 chickens for 61 children. Each child will take care of 1 chicken. When these chickens grow up, the children can have eggs. The chickens will not be sold or killed when they grow old. In this way, children will learn to be grateful to those from whom they got support. They will also learn to be kind and compassionate.

For this project, our class 11 children built a simple chicken coop under the guidance of staff.



3. **Farming project:** In order to be a little self sustainable, we used to grow organic vegetables. For this purpose we bought a tiller and water sprinklers.

Our academic year 2020-2021 ended smoothly and successfully in spite of the pandemic.
