## Schooling

Usually the new academic session in Nepal begins from the mid of April every year. But due to the pandemic of Covid19, the academic session for Nursery to class 9 started from 20<sup>th</sup> June 2021.

The final exam of the last academic year of class 11 Management & Science was conducted from 29<sup>th</sup> June to 4<sup>th</sup> July 2021. And the final exam for class 11 Law was held from 7<sup>th</sup> July to 13<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

The long awaited SEE Board Exam Result of class 10 was declared on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2021. Out of our 9 children, 3 got A+ Grade which means Outstanding and 6 got A Grade which means Excellent. So to celebrate their good result, we organized a simple program on 10<sup>th</sup> August 2021.



The 1<sup>st</sup> Term Exam of the Academic Year 2021-2022 for children up to class 10 was conducted from 26<sup>th</sup> September to 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

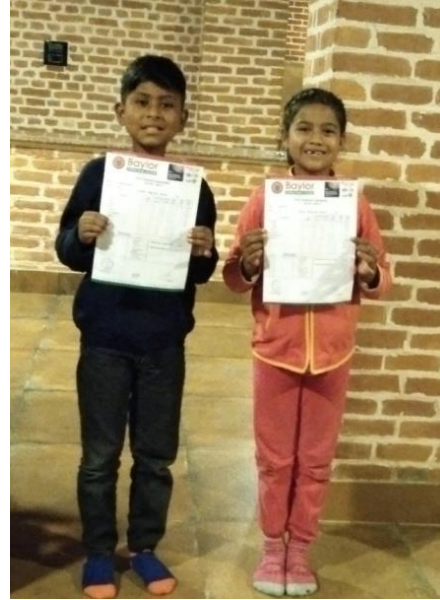
