Schooling:

The **New Academic Session** commenced on 17th April 2025. Therefore, on 15th April, we distributed text books & note books to our children.



During the previous academic session, seven of our children in class 12 appeared for the **School Leaving Certificate (SLC) Examination** held from 4th to 16th May 2025. Their results were published on 4th August 2025, and we are delighted to share that all of them have successfully passed.



The **final exam of class 11** children studying at Baylor International Academy(**BIA**) was conducted from 7th May to 14th May 2025. The result was announced on 22nd May 2025 & we are happy to say that all our 3 children passed successfully. The **New Academic Session of class 12** children studying at **BIA** started from 18th June 2025.

The **final exam of class 11** children studying at **Tej Ganga Multiple Campus** was conducted from 10th May 2025 to 15th May 2025. The result was announced on 24th June 2025. The **new academic session of class 12** children who are studying at **Tej Ganga Multiple Campus** started from 30th June 2025.

The **District level Examination** of class 8 was held from 22nd to 31st March 2026. This year we have seven children who gave this exam. The result was announced on 8th April 2026 & all the children passed this exam.

The final exam of classes 1 to 9 started from 25th March to 2nd April, 2026 & the result was announced on 11th April, 2026. This year we have 4 class toppers with full marks/4.00 GPA. They are Rita Shrestha, Binod Pokharel, Sohan Pariyar & Smriti Humagain. In total 49 children gave this exam & all of them passed.

Dashain

We decorated our home, prepared delicious food & enjoyed by dancing, and receiving tika and jamara from elders. The celebration was joyful, meaningful, and strengthened our family bonds. This year all of our senior children spent their long holiday at Rangeen Home instead of going to their homes because both of their sisters also came for the holidays, allowing the siblings to enjoy precious moments together. Their presence made it more joyful time of togetherness & celebration.



Tihar:

Tihar is celebrated to honor gods, animals, and also the bond between brothers and sisters. During Tihar, we decorated our home with lights, flowers, and colourful rangoli. During the Tihar we worship crows, cows & Goddess Laxmi. We believe that Goddess Laxmi will visit our home during the Laxmi Puja & welcome her by making colourful Rangoli & keeping lamps in front of our home. On Bhai Tika, sisters put tika to their brothers, expressing love and blessings. The festival brought happiness and unity to everyone at Rangeen Home.



Christmas:

During Christmas, our Godparents, **Mrs. Traudi Burgmair & Mr. Andreas Lechner**, are usually with us. However, this year we celebrated without them & deeply felt their absence. Every year, they come as our Santa Claus & bring wonderful gifts for all the children & staff members of Rangeen Home, making the celebration even more special & joyful.

So like every year we celebrated the Christmas by playing Secret Santa where each of us buys a gift for one person, but the receiver does not know who the giver is. It makes the celebration exciting & fun because everyone tries to guess who their Secret Santa is.

Our event is always lively with dance performance, songs, and a beautiful Christmas carols, creating a warm and festive atmosphere.



Saraswati Puja:

On 23rd January 2026, we celebrated Saraswati puja. The day is dedicated to Goddess Saraswati, the goddess of knowledge, wisdom, music and arts. On this special day, we also went to feed the homeless dogs, spreading kindness and compassion.

On 18th February 2026, we celebrated Gyalpo Losar . Gyalpo Losar is celebrated as the New Year by the Tibetans, Sherpas & the Himalayan Buddhist communities in Nepal, Tibet, Bhutan & parts of India. It is celebrated with prayers, cultural programs, feasts & family gatherings.

We got up early morning & respectfully took down the old lungta (Tibetan prayer flags), to let go the past year's negativity. It is believed that as the wind blows through the new flags, it spread positive energy and blessings to all living beings. We also gathered together and danced **Gorshey(circle dance)** with excitement. The home was filled with music, laughter and smiling faces. We also enjoyed lots of delicious food prepared with love by our children from the Himalayan regions. After lunch, we played token games and had lots of fun.

Visit To Kathmandu Fun Park

On 4th April 2026 we took our children from classes 1 to 6 to **Kathmandu Fun Park** for an exciting and joyful outing. Our Godparents Mrs. Traudl Burgmair & Mr. Andreas Lechner, along with our children's beloved sponsors Norin, Daniel, Christina, Christine, Isabel, Sabine & our well-wishers Anna, Karina & Vroni with her little daughter Philo also joined the trip making it more memorable. The children enjoyed a variety of fun rides and games, making the best use of their time at the park. They also did the face painting, which added extra color and excitement to their day.



Trip to Sukute Beach:

This time, our children from classes 7 to 12 got an opportunity to visit Sukute beach. They also had lots of fun playing many games like Volleyball, Table Tennis, and Swimming.



New Admission:

On 4th July 2025, we admitted an 8 year old girl Kamala Rokaya from Mugu District. Her parents went to India with one of her elder sister & since then they never contacted Kamala. So she became like an orphan. She is staying with her paternal uncle & aunt at Nepalgunj where she did not get chance to continue her studies.



On 27th December 2025, we admitted a 6 year old semi orphan girl from Dolpo district. Her mother died due to breast cancer. She has one elder sister & 1 younger brother. So it has become difficult for her father alone to educate and take care of her children.



Health:

On 15th April 2025, a **Health Checkup Camp** was conducted at Rangeen Home which was arranged by Mr. Rabindra Puri. A team of doctors and nurses from Sheer Memorial Hospital came for this Health Checkup Camp.. They carried out general health checkups for the children and provided basic medical guidance and support.



On 30th May 2025, our child **Ms. Ashmita Gurung**, a senior child currently pursuing her CDS (Certificate in Dental Science), conducted an informative session on **Oral Health Awareness** for the younger children. Her presentation was very

interesting for our younger children. This initiative not only promoted better dental health awareness but also encouraged positive habits among the children.



On 6th June 2025, our senior child **Ms. Sangmo Gurung**, studying PCL (Proficiency Certificate Level of Nursing), took the initiative to conduct a special awareness session on **general health education** for the younger children. Her aim was to share the basic knowledge of health and hygiene that she learned through her nursing studies.



On 12th February, 2026 our class 6 girls got vaccinated against HPV (Human Papillomavirus). The Program was conducted by **Health post from Dalinchowk** to protect them from HPV related diseases.



Other Projects:

New Bed sheets

We bought 2 sets of bed sheets & pillow covers for all our children. The stitching is done by our child Santosh Tamang who completed **Diploma in Applied Fashion Designing** from International Institute of Fashion Technology (IIFT), Kathmandu, Nepal.



Solar Water Tank

One of our solar water tanks is damaged. So, we replaced it by a new one.



Water Purifier:

In order to have clean & hygienic water for our children we installed water purifier.



Scooter:

As we need to travel to Banepa frequently to purchase fresh fruits, vegetables, and other essential supplies, we decided to buy a scooter for our cook. This has made shopping trips more convenient & efficient, ensuring that fresh items can be obtained regularly for the children.



Mattresses and blankets:

Some of the mattresses and blankets of our children are very old & damaged. So we replaced them with new mattresses & blankets.



Visit by the group from Asha Shiksha Sadan:

On 2nd November 2025, the children & staff members from Asha Shiksha Sadan visited Rangeen Home to have an experience about how our children are being raised. They spent time observing our daily activities, interacting with our children, and understanding the care, discipline & support provided at our home. So we made the day special by organizing games and various fun activities.



Visit by Shanti Sewa Griha.

Children & staff members from Shanti Sewa Griha visited Rangeen Home & spent their time with us from 14th April to 18th April 2026. The team comprised of 59 children & 3 staff members. The purpose of their visit is to experience the overall atmosphere of Rangeen Home.

We worked together, carried out daily activities together, organized hiking trips, dance, and games and supported one another like a family. We truly hope that the staff members & children of Shanti Sewa Griha felt at home during their time with us.



Farming and Gardening:

Children in Rangeen Home are taught simple farming & gardening. They are taught how to plant seeds and care for them so they grow into healthy organic vegetables. Children are very happy when they harvest the vegetables & crops that they cultivated.



Construction & repair work:

Due to the continuous water leakage from girl's bathroom, bathroom construction and repair work was carried out from 14th December to 29th December 2025.



On 29th March 2026, we fixed new curtains in our dining hall.



During the leisure time, Mr. Phuntsok guided the children & worked alongside them on various small construction & repair activities. Together, they made bamboo furniture for the parents' sitting area, repaired the main gate, fixed broken tiles, cleaned basin pipes, and drainage system. Special attention was also given to keeping the compound clean & well-maintained. These activities keep the children active & help them develop valuable practical life skills.



On 2nd February, repair & maintenance work was carried out at Family Stoffel Foundation under the guidance of Mr. Phuntsok. Necessary repairs were completed, installing lights, repairing the pipes & cleaning the back area of the building. The weeds were removed, hedges trimmed & the entire compound was cleaned, creating a neat & well-maintained environment.
